




HORNSBY HEIGHTS PUBLIC SCHOOL BUSHLAND FAIR 2022

You can purchase as much as you like and it will be ready for collection on the day at the School Entrance (look for the Pick Up Point or Information Station).

When you buy a Family Bundle (available online only), you will receive an additional 10% free.

P&C Fun stations will have games and attractions starting at \$2 Bushland Bucks up to \$10 Bushland Bucks.

P&C Food stations will have meals and treats starting at \$2 Bushland Bucks up to \$10 Bushland Bucks.

Online sales will be available until 5pm on 11th November 2022.

Note: An EFTPOS terminal will be available on the day to purchase Bushland Bucks and cash will be happily taken at all stalls and stations.

HHPS WASTE WARRIORS HELPING FIGHT THE WAR ON WASTE!

The 2022 HHPS Bushland Fair is doing its bit to fight the war on waste with the help of HHPS Waste Warriors and Hornsby Shire Council Waste Management Team.

A CHANGE for the better

This year at the Bushland Fair, we are changing a few things for the better:

1 BINLESS

The Bushland Fair will be totally 'Bin-less'. We are aiming to have **no bins** on site and recycle as much waste as possible in the hope to minimise the amount of landfill.



2 WASTE STATION

The HHPS Waste Warriors will be running a WASTE STATION where <u>ALL</u> Bushland Fair patrons will be expected to take and dispose of their rubbish in the recycling bins available.



3 RECYCLE, RECYCLE, RECYCLE

We are recycling everything we can. Here is what we are recycling:

4 WATER REFILL STATIONS AND BUBBLERS

There will be several water refill stations and bubblers available on the grounds. We will have limited cups available for those without their water bottles!



5 ECO FRIENDLY PACKAGING

Where possible, we have used eco-friendly packaging and containers that are an environmentally friendly alternative to conventional plastic containers and bags. These products are all compostable!



So, what do **YOU** need to do to be a Waste Warrior at the Fair?

Bring your own: • water bottle • food containers • coffee cups • bag	Take ALL waste to the Waste Station	Sort your rubbish into the correct recycling bin (with the help of the Waste Warriors!)







Come and show us your baking skills. Whether you are good at presentation, taste or both, we have a category suitable for you! We have four different age categories with one tasting and one presentation option in each. The taste categories will be judged throughout the day by our guest judges. The presentation category will be judged by votes from the general public.

HOW DO I ENTER?

Registration will be online and there is a fee of \$5 per entry. You will need to register before Monday 7th November. Tasting categories will be capped at 30 entries so judges will have enough time to taste them all.



HOW DO I DISPLAY MY ENTRY?

Entries will need to be dropped off between 9am and 10am on 12th November. Please have your entry displayed on a strong paper plate or cake board, covered if possible (especially the tasting entries as the judges will need to taste these).

WHEN WILL MY ENTRY BE JUDGED?

The taste categories will be judged at certain time slots throughout the day (to be advised). Presentation categories will be open for public voting between 10:30am – 2:00pm.

WHEN CAN I PICK UP MY ENTRY?

Entries can be picked up between 3:00pm – 4:00pm. Any entries that are not collected will either be thrown out or devoured by volunteers.

HOW DO I VOTE?

To vote for your favourite entry in any of our Presentation categories, simply place some Bushland Bucks or cash in the relevant collection box. The entry with the most donations will be crowned the Peoples Choice.

PRIZES:

There will be one major prize in each category. Certificates will be presented for commendations.

Important to note: Please remember that all entries will be on display for most of the day. While every effort will be made to keep the entries cool (in an air conditioned environment), they may get warm if it is a hot day. Please consider this when choosing your style of decorations, flavour/style of cake, etc.
