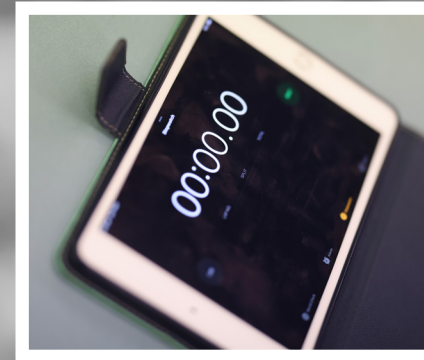


DEBATING
